



CHECKLIST OF FACILITIES GENERATING HEALTHCARE OR INFECTIOUS WASTE

The following facilities are potential sources of healthcare or infectious waste:

- Hospitals, medical centers, and polyclinics
- Clinics
- Small primary health centers, communal health stations, and health posts
- Specialized outpatient treatment centers
- Dialysis centers
- Obstetrics and maternity centers
- Diagnostic centers
- Medical laboratories
- Healthcare teaching establishments
- Biomedical laboratories and research centers
- Biotechnology laboratories and research centers
- Nuclear medicine laboratories
- Blood banks, blood collection centers, and blood transfusion centers
- Physicians' offices
- Dental clinics and offices
- Alternative medicine treatment centers (e.g., acupuncture centers)
- Veterinary hospitals
- Veterinarians' clinics and offices
- Animal research and testing centers
- Animal quarantine stations
- Pharmacies and dispensaries
- Pharmaceutical manufacturing facilities
- Nursing homes for the elderly
- Long-term residential care facilities or hospices for the elderly and chronically ill
- Home health care settings
- Funeral homes and mortuaries
- Health stations in commercial or industrial establishments
- Infirmaries, clinics and health stations in colleges and universities
- Tattoo and cosmetic ear piercing establishments
- Emergency service facilities (ambulance stations, paramedic stations)
- Emergency response facilities (fire stations, rescue operations)
- Hospitals, clinics and health stations in military establishments
- Health stations in police facilities
- Coroners' or medical examiners' facilities, forensic pathology or autopsy laboratories, and crime laboratories
- Drug addiction rehabilitation centers
- Clinics or health stations in prisons
- Health and quarantine stations in airports, ports, and immigration/customs facilities

- Clinics or health stations in children's schools and summer camps
- First-aid posts
